ITINERARY

1

Day 1 Casablanca

Arrival at the Med V airport of casa, welcome by our staff, direction for a panoramic tour along the coast, the port, also the city center. And then to the hotel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

2

Day 2 Casablanca – Rabat

Morning visit the economic capital of Morocco, the central market, the royal palace, Med V square followed by a visit to the Great Mosque Hassan II. Continuation to Rabat the capital of kingdom. Visit of the royal palace “Mechouar”. The Kasbah of Oudayas which overlooks the slope of the river Bou Regreg, the Tower of Hassan and the Necropolis of Chellah. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 3 Rabat – Chefchaouen

Breakfast at Akchour waterfall; A tourist site and a real terrestrial paradise; Natural landscapes, mountains, waterfall; Free lunch, then departure to Chefchaouen. Arrival at the hotel, Moment of rest and relaxation. Then guided tour begins at the Market Place (Outa hammam) and continues towards Kasbah and Souika then you will discover the hundred-year old streets dressed in the unique blue Azureen to relax the daily stress. A stop in La Source Ras EL Ma is obligatory to discover the freshness of this source that feeds the whole city and all the valley underlying. Dinner at the restaurant finally Return to the hotel and overnight

Day 4 Chefchouen – Fès

After breakfast, we will go to Fez via Moulay Idriss, and then the roman ruins of volubilis, the latter is an ancient Berber city then romanized, capital of the kingdom of Mauretania, located in Morocco, on the banks of the river Rhoumane river From the suburbs of Meknes, not far from the city. After lunch we will continue our journey to Meknes, visit the ancient medina, the Bab Mansour portal as well as the modern part of the city. Arrival in Fez. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

5

Day 5 Fez Explorer

After breakfast, the day dedicated to the visit of the spiritual and cultural capital of the Kingdom. The discovery of the city and labyrinth Medina. If one observes Fez from the summit of the hill where one finds the tombs of Merinidi, its urban fabric appears compact and united. Closed between the defensive walls, the historic Medina El Bali is a sea of roofs from which minarets and domes emerge. The Fez River searates the two historical parts of the city: the Andalusian district to the east and the Karaouiyyine district to the west. Its most important features are the Royal Palace and the former Hebraic district. Dinner and overnight in a riad in the heart of the Medina.

6**Day 6****Fez – Imilchil**

Morning departure to Imilchil, passing by the small town of Ifran nicknamed small Switzerland then the Amazigh villages like that of Timahdit, Boumia and Tilmi, Arrival in the center of Imilchil: formerly it was a Casbah which marked the territory of Ait Hdiddou (An important Berber nomadic tribe living in a mountainous region known as “Little Tibet”, this town is also known for the summer of the fiancés (end of august) Night in Imilchil in the Auberge berbere.

7**Day 7****Imilchil – Goulmima**

Departure to Goulmima via Oasis de ghris and Agdal; Plateau lakes, good pasturage traditionally forbidden to herds from the end of March to mid June which allows the grass to regenerate, and then take the trail to Ait Hani to take the road left through many villages Berbers and by gorges. Arrival at the oasis of Chris with date palms and olive trees. Overnight in Goulmima: Guest house l’Oasis.

8**Day 8****Goulmima – Merzouga**

Departure from Goulmina towards the desert of sand through Rissani, crossing many magnificent landscapes. Arrival at the dunes of Merzouga, for the sunset in the desert of sand and a ride on dromedary. Night in bivouac under berber tent.

9**Day 9****Merzouga nomadic life**

After breakfast, you will make the great tour of the dunes passing by the two oases of MERZOUGA, the nomadic depot, the village of KHAMLIA (village of the blacks), the MIFISS mines, the desert plateau to meet Berber nomads, The oasis TISSARDMINE. Return to the hostel around 3 pm for the departure of your camel caravan to watch the sunset in the dunes. You will spend the night in a wild oasis located at 2 hours of walk in full desert. Dinner and night in bivouac under the tent.

10**Day 10****Merzouga – The Gorges of Todra – The Gorges of Dades**

Breakfast return to the Todgha Gorge and the village of Tinghir. Built on a rock spur, to an elongated shape. The various silver mines make the village a rich and known place for jewelry. At about 2km from the wadi are the gorges of Todgha, which offer an extraordinary panorama. The Todgha palm grove is 12km long. Dinner and overnight at the hostel.

11**Day 11****The Gorge of Dades – Skoura**

After breakfast, we make a departure to go up the gorges of the Toudra and take the track that crosses part of the high atlas, we climb up to 2800m of altitude, we will make several stops panorama and some walks, we We will see the nomads under tent and those who have troglodyte dwellings. Continuation on the Dades to visit the village of the rosebushes of Damascus which in May produce essences, perfumes, rose water and scented oils, lunch in the gorges and departure for Skoura where we will take a walk for an hour and a half In the palm grove ... night in a guest house.

12

Day 12

Skoura-Ouarzazate – Marrakech

Departure from Skoura around 8.30am, passage to Ouarzazate, general view of the city and we continue to Ait Benhaddou, old ksar classified in the world heritage of UNESCO. It is here that you will have a break for the lunch, then you can walk on the sloping alleys before leaving for Marrakech by the national road and the Tichka pass ... a few stops panorama and arrival In Marrakech in the late afternoon.
