ITINERARY

1

Day 1

Tanger – Tetouan – Chefchaouen

Welcome to the port or airport of Tangier. After the departure of trip to Tetouan passing by the Mediterranean coast. Following the road to Chefchaouen to visit the city and stroll along the oldest streets in blue and white. Overnight at the hotel.

2

Day 2

Chefchaouen – Volubilis – Fez

The road Drives to Fez via the Rif forest, the Roman ruins of Volubilis for the visit. (Option – local guide). Continuation to Fez by crossing the new city of Meknes. Overnight at hotel.

3

Day 3

Fez – Moulay Driss – Meknes

We will go to Moulay Idriss, where Idriss ben Abdallah was buried in 791, probably the greatest marabout in Morocco. Climbing the steep streets, we will enjoy, from the top of the terraces of the city, an exceptional view. A walk in the medina of Meknes takes us from the Bab-el-Mansour gate to the El-Hedim square and the Dar Jamaï palace, a museum of Moroccan art, then to the remains of the ancient imperial city: the tomb of Moulay Ismail , Heri-es-Souani, vast wheat granaries, and the Agdal basin, dug for the irrigation of the royal gardens. Dinner at the hotel and overnight in Fes.

4

Day 4

Meknes – Rabat

Road to Rabat, now the administrative and political capital of the country, but which was also the second imperial city, after Fez, at the time of Yacoub el-Mansour, at the end of the 12th century. At the mouth of Bou Regreg on the south shore, she looks at Salé, her twin anchored on the north shore. Dominating the estuary, the Kasbah of the Oudaïas recalls the past of Rabat which became a republic of the Corsairs in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries, a refuge for the Moresques expelled from Spain in 1609 by Philip III. We will then visit the Archaeological Museum which offers an excellent panorama of the history of Morocco, from prehistory to the Roman and early Christian period. Lunch included. Crossing the medina, we will reach the merinid necropolis of Chellah, which occupies the site of the ancient Roman city. We will arrive at the Hassan tower and the mausoleum of Mohammed V, which will give the opportunity to recall the recent history of Morocco. Transfer to your accommodation, dinner and overnight.

5

Day 5

Rabat – Casablanca

Visit the second largest city in Africa. On the ridge you can visit the mosque of the late King Hassan II, the second largest mosque in the world after that of Mecca. Dinner and hotel accommodation in Casablanca.

6

Day 6

Casablanca-Asilah-Tanger

Along the Atlantic coast in Asilah. Asilah is a small village of artists, but also fishermen. The Medina is mostly small houses in blue and white. It is surrounded by walls from the moment of Portuguese. You can along the walls of the old military court, where you have a beautiful view of the medina.
